Catastrophic Injuries

This is defined as any condition in which a student athlete's life is threatened or the student athlete risks permanent impairment. Examples include, but are not limited to, respiratory or cardiac arrest, spine injuries and possible fractures.

Call 9-1-1.

Be sure to have the following information:

- ▶ Name, address, telephone number of caller
- ▶ Number of athletes injured
- ▶ Condition of Athlete(s)
- ▶ First aid initiated by first responder
- ▶ Specific directions to emergency scene:
Bloomington Park, 100th & SE STEELE

- 1: From Bloomington Field take SE Steele WEST to 97th and turn left.
- 2: Turn RIGHT on FOSTER RD.
- 3: Turn RIGHT onto I-205 NORTH.
- 4: Take the WASHINGTON/STARK STREET EXIT #20.
- 5: Turn RIGHT on WASHINGTON.
- 6: Turn RIGHT on 99th. The blue hospital sign should be visible here.
- 7: Go past Mall 205 to MAIN STREET and turn LEFT.
- 8: You will see the hospital there. **The Emergency room is located at Main and 101st.**
