Catastrophic Injuries

This is defined as any condition in which a player's life is threatened or the player risks permanent impairment. Examples include, but are not limited to, respiratory or cardiac arrest, spine injuries and possible fractures.

In the event of a catastrophic injury, **Call 9-1-1**.

- Be sure to have the following information:
- Name, address, telephone number of caller
- Number of players injured
- Condition of the player(s)
- First aid initiated by first responder

Emergency services access to fields

The L.O. Fire Department is likely to be on the scene rapidly since they are located downtown, which is about mile away. Direct the emergency services to turn onto Hazel Road from Country Club Road. The football field is immediately on the left hand side. Access is possible alongside the stadium building.

Hospital

The nearest hospital is the Legacy Meridian Park Hospital. It is about 15 minutes drive away from the high school.

- Turn right onto Country Club Road
- Turn left onto Boones Ferry Road
- After 3 miles, turn left and merge onto Interstate 5 south (Salem).
- Leave the Interstate on exit 289 towards Tualatin/Sherwood.
- Turn left on Nyberg Street.

- Left at the top of the hill onto 65th Ave. The turning into the hospital is immediately on your left. You'll see the sign for the emergency room from the road.
